The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111 dated 28.04.2017 under Sections 323/324/354/506/509 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar City.

This Court was pleased to pass the following order on 09.06.2016 :-

“Notice of motion, returnable by 17.08.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigations and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.111 dated 28.04.2017 under Sections 323/324/354/506/509 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar City, on furnishing the bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting officer/Investigating Officer.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that pursuant

to the order dated 09.06.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 09.06.2017 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police; will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
