JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.155 dated 25.12.2016, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned AAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation. In fact, an affidavit has already been furnished by the complainant that the matter stands compromised.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.01.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
