This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 172 dated 24.08.2012 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda, for the offence under Section 420/120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states in pursuance of the order dated 16.06.2017, granting interim anticipatory bail, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He has further submitted that the petitioner is neither required for custodial interrogation, nor for further investigation.
