Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present appeal is covered by a decision of this Court dated 14.01.2014 passed in

FAO No.1543 of 1999 – Jasbir Kaur and another vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation and others, which reads as under:-

“1. The challenge in appeal is to an order passed by the Tribunal closing the evidence on the side of the appellants. The appellants' contention is that they have evidence to offer and the case relates to claim for death arising out of death of a male and the claimants are widow, minor daughter and the father. In the interest of justice, the order impugned is set aside. The appellants shall have an opportunity to bring all the witnesses whom they want to examine and the Tribunal will dispose of the case in accordance with law giving utmost priority to the case considering the fact that the case relates to the accident that took place in the year 1996.

2. The appeal is allowed and the case is remitted to MACT, Fatehgarh Sahib which will be the Tribunal of

competent jurisdiction in the reassigned jurisdiction. For appearance of parties before the MACT, Fategarh Sahib on 07.02.2014.”

In view of the above, the present appeal is allowed in the same terms.
