By this petition, the petitioners seek “transit bail/anticipatory bail” for a short period to enable them to approach the jurisdictional Court in Karnataka, so as to apply for anticipatory bail on merits in respect of FIR No.87 registered on 19.05.2017 at Police Station Sampigehalli, District Bengaluru, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 381 and 120-B read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the FIR is dated 19.05.2017, it came to the knowledge of the petitioners after getting it translated from Kannada, only a few days ago, the petitioners actually being resident of District Fatehgarh Sahib in Punjab.

Without making any comment whatsoever on the merits of the case for or against the petitioners, simply to enable them to approach the jurisdictional Court in Bangalore to apply for anticipatory bail on merits before the concerned Court there, interim bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib is granted to the petitioners till 20.06.2017. If the petitioners do not approach the jurisdictional Court by 20.06.2017, this interim order would have lapse.
