The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No. 17 of 2015, dated 18.02.2015, under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a housewife, has been arraigned as accused on the allegation that an amount of ₹50,000/- was deposited in her account, whereas the said account is held jointly in the name of the petitioner's husband and the petitioner.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that an amount of ₹50,000/- was deposited in her account although the said account is stated to be jointly held by her along with her husband, namely, Ranjit Singh. The petitioner is a lady and the main allegations in the complaint are directed against Ranjit Singh.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
