The petitioner is seeking a direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to look into the complaint dated 16.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) filed by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had taken land on lease but as the crops failed, he could not pay the lease money. The respondent No. 4, who is a police official, has forcibly made the petitioner sign some documents pertaining to land and is also threatening to take possession of the house of the petitioner. Learned counsel further contends that he had sent a complaint dated 16.04.2017 (Annexure P-3) in this regard to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jagroan, District Ludhiana but no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel also submits that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide his complaint dated 16.04.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the complaint of the petitioner in accordance with law

within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
