The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.48 dated 14.04.2016 under Section 379-A IPC registered at Police Station GRP Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and even in the FIR, it is stated by the complainant that he was travelling in the train from Bathinda to Jaipur and when he reached Railway Station Jharli, an old person woke him up and told him that somebody has stolen his luggage and Rs.40,000/- is missing from his pocket. Learned counsel further states that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of Anil, who has been granted regular bail by the trial Court. The petitioner is in custody for over 8 months ever since he was arrested on 02.12.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner being in custody for over 8 months and co-accused being released on bail, I consider it a fit case to grant him regular bail.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Akesh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
