With the assistance of Ms. Vibha Dhiman, Advocate/Mediator, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. A written settlement/agreement dated 23.03.2017 duly signed by the parties, has been placed on record. It has been agreed that Tanushree (petitioner) and Shiv Kapoor (respondent No.1) will file a joint petition for divorce under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act. Shiv Kapoor has already filed a petition for divorce before the Family Court at Gurgaon. The said petition will be converted into a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Shiv Kapoor will also give Rs.45,00,000/- to Tanushree-petitioner and her minor child namely Sanchi (aged about 7 years) as permanent alimony for their past, present and future maintenance. The petitioner will withdraw all

the complaints, which have been filed against her husband.

Since the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, this petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise/settlement deed dated 23.03.2017.
