The present petition has been filed under Section 438 the Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 156 dated 25.11.2016 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station City Batala Police District Batala.

On 13.06.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the prime accused in the FIR, i.e. the husband of the complainant, namely Vikram, has already been admitted to interim bail by this Court in CRM-M-2115-2017, and the said case is coming up for hearing on 18.07.2017. He further submits that in fact the matter has been referred to mediation. Notice of motion returnable on 18.07.2017. To be heard with CRM-M-2115-2017. In the meanwhile, on petitioners joining investigation, in case they are sought to be

arrested, they would be released on bail, on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Ilaqa Magistrate. They shall, further, abide by all the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 13.06.2017, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 13.06.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
