ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.124 dated 25.05.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 380, 427, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner in the FIR and only allegation against him is that it was at his behest that the main accused caused injury to the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner was also not present at the place of occurrence.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Trilok Singh, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 13.06.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.
