The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 04.11.2016 under Sections 324/341/323/506/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which is attributed to the petitioner is on non-vital part of the body of complainant and a cross case has also been registered by the petitioner who himself suffered four injuries on his person. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 14.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 14.06.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
