Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 108, dated 15.05.2017, for offences punishable under Sections 494, 419, 420, 465, 468 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to order dated 14.06.2017, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by the Investigating Officer, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that the petitioners are no longer required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioners by this Court's order dated 14.06.2017, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
