ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 137 dated 21.05.2017 registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 420, 120B IPC at Police Station City Khanna.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of a dispute between the petitioners and sister of petitioner No.1 which has now been resolved.

This Court, vide order dated 11.07.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, states that in pursuance to the order dated 11.07.2017, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 11.07.2017 granting ad-interim bail is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
