This petition seeks a direction to the respondent-State and its functionaries, i.e. respondents no.1 to 4, not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondent no.5, the reason for such alleged harassment being, as stated in the petition, that respondent no.5 had lost some litigation with the petitioner.

The petition is seen to be filed on 06.07.2016. Thereafter, it came up for hearing on 11.07.2016, 01.08.2016, 08.09.2016 and 01.12.2016, with the learned counsel for the petitioner having made a request for adjournment on each occasion. In between it is seen that none had appeared for the petitioner on 10.11.2016, 16.01.2017 and thereafter on 02.03.2017. Even today none has appeared.

Obviously, the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing his

grievance made in the petition, or the matter has been settled due to which the petition is not being argued.

In the aforesaid circumstances, it is dismissed.
