ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 25.05.2017, under Section 382 IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR was the result of misunderstanding between the petitioner, who is a liquor contractor and another contractor, which has now been resolved. He further contends that no recovery of any liquor has been effected from the petitioner as per the contents of the FIR.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.06.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
