The present petition has been filed under Section 438

Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 21 dated 21.04.2017  
registered under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station  
GRP Pathankot, District Pathankot.

On 14.06.2017 this Court had passed the following  
order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
'immediate allegations' were against the parents of the  
petitioner, i.e. the mother-in-law and father-in-law of the  
deceased girl, who have already been admitted to anticipatory  
bail by this court, vide an order dated 22.05.2017 passed in  
CRM-M-18299-2017.

He further submits that the petitioner, in any case was serving  
in the Border Security Force, at Srinagar at the time when his  
wife committed suicide.

Notice of motion returnable on 04.08.2017 i.e. the date already fixed in the CRM-M-18299 of 2017.

To be heard along with that case.

Interim order in the same terms.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 14.06.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 14.06.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
