Consequently, without making any comment at all with regard to the merits of the contentions raised, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Barnala (respondent no.3), to look into the complaint stated to have been filed before him on 30.05.2017, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition, and to take action as per law and ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is duly protected and that he is not harassed at the hands of respondent no.5.
