The petitioners are seeking quashing of the cross version registered vide Rapat No. 22 dated 20.01.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC in case bearing FIR No. 81 dated 20.12.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 326, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, Tehsil Phillaur, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel on a minor issue. The matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectables.

This Court vide order dated 09.08.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to the genuineness of compromise. The report of Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, dated 19.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any pressure or coercion.

The FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel on a minor issue. The matter has been compromised and the parties want to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the law laid down in "*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and cross version registered vide Rapat No. 22 dated 20.01.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC in case bearing FIR No. 81 dated 20.12.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 326, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilga, Tehsil Phillaur, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
