The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 02.05.2017 under Sections 302/307/506/336/148/149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends challan has been presented only under Sections 323/341/342/506/148/149 IPC which all are bailable offences.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhminder Singh, states that indeed the challan has been presented against the petitioner under Sections 323/341/342/506/148/149 IPC only.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that this petition has rendered infructuous as all the offences under which the challan has been filed are bailable and the petitioner shall be submitting his bail bonds before the trial Court in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of as infructuous.
