The petitioner has challenged the order dated 09.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, whereby permission to go abroad, has been declined in FIR No.302 dated 10.09.2011 under Sections 420/467/468/471 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is a professional who arranges shows of various singers. The shows are being held this month in Canada. He further contends that the petitioner had been convicted in FIR No.21 dated 24.01.2011 under Sections 307/452 IPC registered at Police Station Beas and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year vide judgment dated 05.08.2015 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amrtisar.

The appeal preferred by the petitioner against the said judgment dated 05.08.2015 had already been admitted and his sentence had also been suspended during the pendency of appeal. It is further contended that petitioner preferred an application bearing CRM No. 17020 of 2017 in CRA No. S-3552-SB of 2015 seeking permission to go abroad, which was allowed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 01.06.2017, subject to his furnishing heavy solvent sureties to the satisfaction of trial Court. It was also directed that the petitioner would be at liberty to get his passport renewed and he was to return back by 31.08.2017.

Learned counsel further contends that petitioner is on bail since 2011 and he has never misused the concession of bail.

Heard.

A perusal of the impugned order dated 09.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) reveals that permission to go abroad was declined on the ground that while granting bail, three conditions were imposed upon the petitioner by this court. Therefore, he has preferred instant petition before this Court.

The co-ordinate Bench of this Court had granted permission to the petitioner to go abroad in the appeal which is pending adjudication.

The petitioner is on bail and has never misused the concession of bail. It would be in the interest of justice, if he is granted permission to go abroad in the aforementioned FIR as well.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. Petitioner Amrinderpal Singh is permitted to go to Canada subject to his furnishing heavy solvent sureties to the satisfaction of trial Court. The petitioner shall return by 31.08.2017, as directed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
