The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 09.10.2016 registered under Sections 341, 412, 120-B, 395 & 365 IPC at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 23.06.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no other case is pending against the petitioner anywhere, including the area of Delhi. The petitioner has been arrayed as accused on the disclosure statement of one of the accused. The property has been recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the petitioner will file an undertaking that he would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to give undertaking on affidavit as stated above, I am inclined to make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Interim order dated 23.06.2017 is made absolute.
- (ii) The CRL. MISC. No.M-21932 OF 2017 is allowed, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from today that he will not commit any type of offence again and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station as aforesaid.
