Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of the case in FIR No.70 dated 07.09.2016 under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 of IPC (Sections 307/326/325 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar (Rural) to some senior Police Officer as the petitioner is not expecting fair and impartial investigation at the hands of present Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has already completed investigation and submitted challan on 27.11.2017.

In view of aforesaid development when the matter is seized with the trial Court, present petition no more survives. However, petitioner is at liberty to take all possible pleas as available to him under law during trial.

Dismissed as infructuous.
