ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.194 dated 01.11.2015 under Sections 379/447/511/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sahnewal Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury. The petitioner was earlier granted anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, which was dismissed on the ground that he was not cooperating in the investigation. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 15.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and undertakes to make himself available in the investigation, as and when required to do so.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, states that the petitioner has indeed joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.06.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
