ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.83 dated 05.05.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that although in the FIR, it is alleged that the petitioner was armed with baseball bat but no injury has been attributed to him in the FIR. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 15.06.2017 of the coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Madan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.06.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
