Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Gopal Singh, Gurdial Singh, Gurpreet Singh and Baljit Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.63 dated 23.03.2017 at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar under Section 8-B of the National Highways Act, 1956.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 16.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Agyapal Singh from Police Station Beas, District Amritsar who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 16.06.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). However, the same shall be subject to furnishing of two bail bonds with heavy sureties to the tune of Rs.1.00 lakh each by each of the petitioners. Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
