INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Harvinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to arrest respondent No.4 in order to face the legal proceedings arising out of complaint No.198/2015, titled as 'Harvinder Singh vs. Mandhir Singh', under Section 138 of N.I. Act, pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, as respondent No.4 has been declared proclaimed person by the concerned court on 01.06.2015.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has not filed any application before the trial Court to redress his grievance. The trial Court is knowing all the facts and is having case file/record with it.

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Furthermore, petitioner can give address to the court where respondent No.4 is residing and can be apprehended. The trial Court can also give direction to the police for arrest of the accused.

In view of all these facts, instant petition is dismissed with direction to the petitioner to first apply before the trial Court/ Magistrate.
