The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.65 dated 30.04.2017 under Section 61 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana.

This Court, vide order dated 12.07.2017, had directed the petitioners to join investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Kamaljit Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 12.07.2017 the petitioners have joined investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 12.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
