Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case FIR No. 36 dated 7.5.2017, registered under Section(s) 61(1)(6) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 IPC at Police Station Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and he is not required for further investigation in any way. Thus, he be released on pre-arrest bail.
