I have perused the reply filed by way of affidavit of Shri
Kulwant Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narwana

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners
are facing social boycott and not only that petitioner No.2 was also
assaulted and the reason is social boycott by the others. The aforesaid reply
shows that the investigation made by concerned police officer, in which it is
stated that the respondents were the villagers of the Panchayat and have no

concerned with the marriage of the petitioners No.1 and 2 because they belongs to some other place. On the contrary, it is submitted that petitioner No.2 had committed theft of Gas Cylinder and stove from the school of village.

Be that as it may, it appears that the petitioners have been married in the year, 2015 against the wishes of the Panchayat of the village. In that view of the matter, the Superintendent of Police, Jind is directed ought to take supervisory steps to see that the life of the petitioners is not threatened. Necessary steps may be taken, petition is thus disposed of.
