SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

The present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for regular bail of the petitioner in FIR No. 47 dated 19.4.2017 under Sections 279 and 337 IPC (Section 304 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sector 19, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was, in fact, involved in motor vehicle accident case under Sections 279 and 337 IPC and Section 304 IPC was added lateron, just on the statement of the complainant, whereas it was case of motor vehicle accident only, resulting into death of wife of the complainant, namely; Rambha. The petitioner is in custody since 19.4.2017 and trial of the case still to take some time, so the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned State counsel as well as counsel for the complainant, while opposing the bail application, contended that the present case is a cold

blooded murder and intentional accident had taken place because of the fact that Rambha was also working as a labourer and there was a dispute some days prior to the accident and to settle that account, this murder was committed, which was given the shape of motor vehicle accident.

Having considered the fact that initially case under Sections 279 and 337 IPC was registered involving motor vehicle accident; the petitioner is in custody since 19.4.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, therefore, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Chandigarh.

The petition stands allowed.
