ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 30.03.2016 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had taken a sum of ₹.7,00,000/- from the complainant to send his son abroad. However, the details thereof, including the date on which the money had been paid, are not mentioned in the FIR.

This Court, vide order dated 11.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rachhpal Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 11.07.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 11.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
