**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, JUDGE (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 32, dated 31.03.2017, under Sections 22/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, who has been roped in on the statement of Jatinder Kumar from whom 40 gms intoxicant substance has been recovered. Jatinder Kumar is brother-in-law of the petitioner and due to family dispute, they are not on talking terms and are residing separately.

Learned State counsel contends that in terms of previous order dated 16.06.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the fact that the recovery effected from Jatinder Kumar is of less than the commercial quantity and the petitioner has only been named by Jatinder Kumar, the order dated 16.06.2017 passed by this Court granting *ad interim* bail is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
