ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.20 dated 15.03.2017, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Sadar, Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner, who is working as a Peon, are that she had received Rs.1.5 lacs from the complainant on the pretext of getting him job of Secretary at Saharanpur. He further states that the FIR was the result of misunderstanding and the matter has been compromised with the complainant.

This Court, by the order dated 07.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting

Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 07.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
