The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.274 dated 22.05.2017 under Sections 65/66/67 of Information and Technology Act, 2000 (Sections 153-A/295-A IPC added later on) , registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has apologized for posting the questionable material on facebook and the matter has been compromised.

This Court, by the order dated 27.09.2017 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 27.09.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 27.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
