Sandeep Gusar, the petitioner has sought regular bail in a case registered by way of FIR No. 27 dated 19.01.2017 at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat, for an offence punishable under sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 34 IPC.

The instant FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant Mukesh Khatri son of Narender Singh, on the allegations that he had opened an account with HDFC Bank. One Mr. Sanjay Sharma called him stating that the bank had a promotional offer whereby a loan of Rs.10,00,000/- would be sanctioned if a customer deposited 10% thereof (i.e. 1.00 lac with the bank) which would be treated as life insurance premium on his behalf. On that assurance, the complainant deposited a sum of Rs.32,700/- in the account of standards solutions on 19.08.2016 and an amount of Rs.55,000/- on 1.09.2016. However, the promised loan was not sanctioned.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. Even in the charge sheet filed under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the Court, no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2017.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2017 and the trial would take a long time to conclude. The petition is allowed.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat.
