Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.12 dated 09.03.2017 under Sections 306, 34 Act, registered at Police Station GRP Karnal, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that even before the date of alleged suicide, petitioner No.1-Pooja, who is the wife of deceased-Naresh Kumar, has recorded a DDR against her husband on 07.03.2017 and he was admitted on bail in that case on 08.03.2017. The deceased-Naresh Kumar was in a habit of consuming liquor. Petitioner No.1-Pooja is at advance stage of pregnancy. There

is no serious allegation against petitioner No.2-Rekha (unmarried), who is real sister of petitioner No.1.

On the other hand, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant have argued that the petitioners are in custody since 09.03.2017 and there are specific allegations against them which made the deceased-Naresh Kumar to commit suicide. He was not allowed to enter in the house on the night of 08.03.2017.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Admittedly, petitioner No.1 is at advance stage of pregnancy. Considering the fact that the petitioners are in custody since 09.03.2017 and the conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioners on bail.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on bail on their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
