The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.66 dated 21.05.2017 under Sections 452/324/323/506/427/148/ 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature. He further contends that in pursuance to the order dated 19.06.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurcharan Singh, states that the petitioners have indeed joined

the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.06.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
