The allegation in the present petition is that respondents No.5 and 6, who are resourceful persons have used their influence over respondent No.4 to get him to pressurize the petitioner to sell his land to respondent No.5 without any consideration. In that regard, the petitioner has been summoned by the SHO, Police Station, Makhu-respondent No.4 to the police station on many occasions and made to sit there from morning to evening.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though a complaint (Annexure P-1) in this regard was moved by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur but no action has been taken thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2, i.e. Senior

Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into representation (Annexure P-1) and take necessary action, in accordance with law.

In view of above, without in any way commenting on the merit of this case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into representation (Annexure P-1) and take such necessary action as may be warranted in law.
