By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.24 dated 11.03.2017, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana.

It is contended that in pursuance of order dated 19.06.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 state that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, the petitioner uploaded the photograph on social media site and has not returned the educational certificates, passport and other documents of respondent No.2.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the academic testimonials, passport and other documents in the absence of which, respondent No.2 is unable to apply for any job and despite her assurance in the compromise, have not been returned by the petitioner despite availing repeated opportunities and thus misusing the concession of interim bail.

In the circumstances, the Court feels that the conduct of the petitioner in misusing the interim bail dis-entitles him of the relief sought in the present petition. Thus, no case for pre-arrest bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
