The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.212 dated 25.08.2015 for the offence under Sections 304B, 302, 120B IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Surender Singh, informed the Court that as per deposition of Dr.Rajneesh Kumar, Medical Officer, cause of death is asphyxia due to hanging. There was no external mark of injuries on body except ligature mark which is 2 CM wide. The petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased Neeraj and she is in custody from 17.11.2015. Out of 28 witnesses, 13 witnesses have been examined, 8 witnesses have been given up and after examination of doctor, total 6 witnesses are yet to be examined in the matter.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that appeal is not likely to mature in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
