Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.376 dated 24.09.2016 registered under Sections 379-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division-A, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 24.07.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate, to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report as to whether the parties have compromised the matter amicably with their free will and without any pressure from any corner.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Additional

Sessions Judge, Amritsar and got recorded their statements for compromise

and report from the concerned Court has also been received vide letter bearing No.204 dated 18.08.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide Endorsement No.7680-R dated 21.08.2017.

According to the report of Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, the parties have entered into compromise out of their free will with regard to the occurrence as contained in the present F.I.R. without any pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.376, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
