Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.13 dated 6.5.2017, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala.

This Court vide order dated 19.6.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to

order dated 19.6.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Jagtar Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.6.2017 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
