HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner belongs to poor Scheduled Caste family. He is doing the work of collecting the dry bones of the dead animals from his own village and from adjoining villages. It is averred that respondents No.5 to 11 are harassing the petitioner. In this regard, he has made a complaint dated 20.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 but no action thereon has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the complaint and take necessary action.

In these circumstances, without in any way commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner as contained in the complaint dated 20.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take necessary action in accordance with law.
