This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 61 dated 29.11.2016 registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the chemical examiners' report received, the quantity of contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner, is below commercial quantity and with the 'challan' still not having been presented to the competent Court, the petitioner has been in custody since 29.11.2016.

Upon query, learned State counsel on instructions from the police official, who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that no other criminal case has been registered against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the trial is likely to take long as yet, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to

bail upon her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
