This is a petition for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No. 270 dated 20.12.2016 registered under Sections 147/148/149/216/323/506/302 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of SC/ST Act at Police Station Badhra, District Bhiwani (now District Charkhi Dadri).

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are five accused and out of them, two have applied for regular bail and their role was only to the extent that they were present alongwith the main accused. He further submits that only material witnesses i.e. eye witnesses and complainant party had been examined and they turned hostile and have not supported the prosecution case.

In view of above, I find that no useful purpose will be served in continuing the detention of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without making any observation on the merits of this case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
