LISA GILL, J.

This is a second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint No. 32107/2003 dated 01.04.2003. The petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 03.01.2015 passed by the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Phillaur. He approached this Court by filing CRM-M No. 1984 of 2015, which was dismissed on 27.01.2015. While dismissing the said petition, it was observed that in case the petitioner surrendered before the learned trial Court within four days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, his application for bail, if any, would be considered and decided by the learned trial Court expeditiously in accordance with law.

The petitioner admittedly did not surrender. The present petition has now been filed on the ground that the petitioner was taken in custody on 15.04.2015 in FIR No. 404 registered under Section 420 IPC and released in May 2016. In the interregnum his mother passed away on 29.04.2016.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
