This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 51 dated 21.06.2016 registered under Sections 120-B, 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Women Police Station Yamuna Nagar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

An application i.e. CRM No.3829 of 2017 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners for withdrawal of this petition.

It is submitted that during the intervening period, the police has submitted a cancellation report in the above mentioned FIR. It is further brought to the notice of this Court that the said cancellation report has been accepted. The complainant has suffered a statement that she has no objection to the cancellation report.

Learned counsel for the State has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Rajesh Kalia, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar on behalf of respondent No.1 in Court today, wherein the above mentioned facts are affirmed and verified. The said reply is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

In view of the facts and circumstances as noted above, the application is allowed.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
