The record shows that there was a delay of 5 days in lodging of the FIR. Occurrence took place almost 2 years ago on 07.08.2015. The offence under Section 326 IPC was added subsequently and the only grievous injury appears to be a fracture on the thumb of the victim.

Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioners, they are ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions as are deemed appropriate by the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
