The sole prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of directions to official respondents to handover the investigation in case FIR No.24 dated 01.04.2015 registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran to some independent investigation agency.

This Court on 12.08.2016 noticed as under:-

“Contends that the petitioner, who is a young boy of 20 years has been falsely implicated at the behest of one Kala Singh, against whom the father of the petitioner is a witness in a theft case. He refers to Annexure P-10 to contend that immediately before the arrest of the petitioner, Kala Singh called the arresting officer, Sanjeevan Singh. The recovery was effected in the presence of DSP Suba Singh. Against the false implication of the petitioner, a representation was addressed to respondent No.2, who has further marked the inquiry to the same officer i.e. DSP Suba Singh.”

On instructions, the learned State counsel submits that the inquiry was in fact conducted by SP (Investigation), Tarn Taran as reflected in the reply filed through respondent-State. In view of this factual aspect of the matter, this Court feels that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
